DIX BREAKS HUMBOLDT COURSE RECORD

Chico State's Roger Dix blazed to a record time of 24:50 on Humboldt State's five mile course over the weekend. Roger's time erases the old course record formerly held by Division II National Champion and Olympic Marathon runner Mark Conover. Chico was narrowly defeated by one point as the Lumberjacks held onto a 30 to 31 victory on their home course. Humboldt's Dennis Schipper led throughout most of the race until Dix took command with a half mile to go and finished pulling away. Chico's Andy McCutcheon also turned in an exceptional performance finishing third with a time of 25:19 over the slow course. Alberto Gomez and Dave Larabee both turned in fine performances finishing 6th and 8th overall with times of 25:25 and 25:37 respectively. Ralph Lewis, Chris Knorz and Jose Rodriguez finished Chico's scoring by placing 13th, 15th and 17th with times of 26:22, 26:37 and 26:50 respectively.

WILDCAT WOMEN RUN WELL AT HUMBOLDT

Chico State's women ran very well at Humboldt State despite not having three of their top seven runners at the meet. Chico placed third behind Humboldt and San Francisco State, however, had Chico brought their full team the outcome would have been much different. Liz Mozier paced the Wildcats with a fourth place finish over the 5k course as she had yet another steady performance finishing the race with a time of 18:58. Sarah Meek had one of her best performances of the year finishing 6th overall with a time of 19:30. Also having another good race was Julie Stai who finished right behind Sarah in 7th place with a time of 19:35. Alicia Telles and Noel Foster also had solid performances finishing 13th and 16th overall with times of 20:20 and 20:35 respectively.
