WILDCAT WOMEN PLACE THIRD AT SONOMA

Chico's Sue Hansen paced the Wildcats to another strong performance over the weekend at the Sonoma Invitational. Hansen finished the race in 6th place with a personal best time of 17:24 over the 5K course. The Wildcats finished third in the meet defeating last years second place conference team from Hayward State. Liz Mosier, Cindy Gaona, Julie Stai and Sarah Meek all ran extremely well finishing 25th, 29th, 32nd and 35th with times of 18:41, 18:52, 19:02 and 19:29 respectively. Gaona and Meek's times were both personal bests for a 5K course and each runner finished the race with a strong kick. Also running well for Chico were Alicia Telles, Sharon Dick-Lane and Linda Frank finishing 47th, 48th and 49th with times of 19:59, 20:05 and 20:06 respectively. A total of twelve teams took part in the meet including last year's regional champions Cal Poly SLO.

CHICO MEN FINISH FOURTH

Chico State's mens team finished fourth at the Sonoma State Invitational over the weekend despite running without three of their top seven runners. Roger Dix once again paced the Wildcats finishing 4th with a fine time of 25:01 over the 5 mile course. Dave Larabee had another consistent performance placing 18th overall with a time of 25:51. Chris Knorzer, Jose Rodriguez and Cris Markey rounded out the top five finishing 27th, 33rd and 40th overall with times of 26:34, 27:10 and 27:35 respectively. Gary Towne and Curtis Sullivan finished up the race in 41st and 45th place with times of 27:37 and 27:53. A total of 73 runners took part in the race.
