Phil Rochleau of Paradise won the varsity boys' race with a time of 15 minutes, 47.1 seconds. Chico's top runner, Brooks Von Bargen, was not able to finish the race. John Noyes was Chico's top finisher, crossing the line 19th at 17:24.1.

Tina Gorbet of Lassen (Susanville) proved again that she has

no equal in this area, finishing first at 12:53. Her closest challenger was Orland's Trixie Robbins, 13:16.07. Alicia Mercer of Pleasant Valley was third (13:31.1), and Julie Van Dyke of Chico was fifth (14:13.6). Van Dyke and Stephanie Moran were named to the all-EAL list.

Robbins was a non-award winner as Durham and Orland competed for schedule only this year.

Joel Kruger (Paradise) was the top JV boys' finisher, at 12:08.23; Gary Ford of Pleasant Valley finished second at 12:12.62. Joah Randall and Josh Hubbard, both of Chico, were fourth and fifth with times of 12:21.47 and 12:26.40.

Irene Cardenas of Bidwell Junior High won the JV girls' race, posting a time of 13:49.2. Kerry Houchin of Chico Junior was second, 14:19.8. Lassen won the team competition with 63 points, followed by Chico (30) and Bidwell (28).
